Church History

The First Bethel Baptist Church of Capitol Heights Maryland was organized and held our initial Worship Service on Sunday, December 23, 2012 under the dynamic leadership of our beloved Pastor and Organizer, Dr. Lehman D. Bates, **GOD BLESS our SECOND ANNIVERSARY!** The initial service was held at our present location, 9171 Central Avenue, Capitol Heights, MD with a total of 47 members. The Lord allowed us to grow and we were officially incorporated in January 2013 with a Charter Membership of 83 Members. Today we thank God for a total of 112 members. In February the church created a new bank account "new location fund" as we continue to fast, pray and be lead by the Holy Spirit to our permanent worship location.

GOD has continued to bless us as our Pastor resumed his full schedule of delivering the Gospel Message too many local and out-of state churches for their special days. The Deacon's Ordination Service was held on Sunday, June 29, 2014 for Deacons; Dwight S. Artis, Kelvin E. Cooke, Murphy L. Hackett and John Mozon. Rhonda L. The Pastor and Church Anniversary was Sunday, July 27th with guest preacher Dr. Keith Rolle. The first Church Leadership Workshop was held on Saturday, May 3rd with Dr. Milton Lewis as the presenter.

After much prayer and planning the Travel Fellowship Committee sponsored three successful church trips and outings. First to see the production of Moses in March, the First Bethel Baptist Church Cookout in Greenbelt and a Crab Feast Dinner Cruise both in July. The Drama Group sponsored their first pizza party for the youth on August 21st.

Also, the church mourned the passing of our member, Mrs. Theresa Jeffries at the age of 93 on July 14th and the passing of Deacon Arthur Tyler of FBCMH and Dr. G. Thomas Turner of Columbus, Ohio. We have supported bereaved families within and outside our church, and we continue to pray for our members that experienced the passing of their husband, father, mother, daughter, sister, brother or other close relative.
